

### **Infant/Minor/Pregnancy Policy**

Infants sailing on a cruise must be at least 6 months old as of the first day of the cruise or cruisetour. For Transatlantic, Transpacific, Hawaii, selected South America and other selected cruise or cruisetour, the infant must be at least 12 months old as of the first day of sailing. Infants who do not satisfy these requirements will be denied boarding and this may result in the denial of boarding of one or more guests sailing with the infant. No refund or other compensation will be given by the cruiseline.

For minors below 21 years not cruising with parents, please ensure that the consent letter is filled in by the parent giving authorization for the minor to travel with said guardian, and authorizing the guardian to act on behalf of the minor should medical attention be required. Non-compliance will result in denied boarding. All minors under age 21 must be booked in a cabin with an adult above age 21 or in an adjacent cabin with the parent/guardian.

For minors below age 21 cruising with one parent, please bring along a copy of the minor's birth certificate as proof that the minor is travelling with a parent.

Guests who have entered their 24th week of pregnancy as of the sail date will not be accepted to cruise. A physicians "Fit to Travel" letter stating that they are in good health, not in a high risk pregnancy, and not entering the 24th week of pregnancy is required. Failure to produce said letter will result in denied boarding.

### **Fuel Surcharge**

Royal Caribbean International reserves the right to impose a fuel supplement on all guests if the price of West Texas Intermediate fuel exceeds USD65 per barrel. The fuel supplement for 1st and 2nd guest would be no more than USD10 per guest per day, to a maximum of USD140 per cruise; and for 3rd and 4th guest would be no more than USD5 per guest per day, to a maximum of USD70 per cruise.

### **Check-In Terminal in Shanghai for 08 October sailing**

Due to on-going construction at Baoshan Terminal in Shanghai, Legend of the Seas will dock in Waigaoqiao Haitong Terminal during the month of October. All guests are to report to the Shanghai Port International Cruise Terminal (SIPG) for check-in and then be transferred to the Waigaoqiao Pier for boarding. All guests must be at the SIPG Terminal 90 minutes prior to the ship's set sail time to ensure that all guests are able to embark on time.
